4. FIRST-AID MEASURES

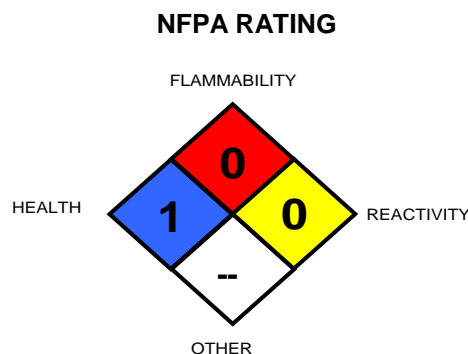
